OUR METHOD

Camps - Camps are a time of inspiration and perspiration for athletes and coaches who want to reach their potential through comprehensive athletic, spiritual, and leadership training. FCA provides sports, coaches, leadership, and local day camps.

Campus - FCA's Campus Ministry is initiated and led by student athletes and coaches on junior high, high school, and college campuses. They have numerous ways to minister to campuses through TeamFCA Bible Studies, Chapel Programs, One Way 2 Play, Fields of Faith, Huddles, and community outreach. Huddles also team up with other campus ministries in joint efforts to impact their communities.

Coaches - At the heart of FCA are coaches. Our role is to minister to these men and women by encouraging and equipping them to know and serve Christ through Bible studies, staff contacts, prayer support, discipleship and mentoring, resources, outreach events, camps, and retreats.

Community - The non-school based FCA ministries reach the community through partnerships with the local churches, businesses, parents, and volunteers. These ministries not only reach out to the community, but also allow the community to invest in athletes and coaches.

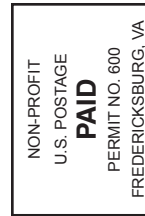

Scott Pilkington has served as Pastor at New Life Church of God in Orlando, Florida, in a full-time capacity for approximately 16 years.

Scott was born and raised in Eldorado, Illinois, where he attended High School and was a three-sport athlete. He graduated in 1986. He and his wife, Lorrie have been married for 18 years, and have two children, Jordan (15) and Joshua (13).

He attended Union University on a baseball scholarship in Jackson, Tennessee, where he majored in Education in 1990. He is currently working on his Master's Degree at Asbury Theological School. Upon graduating from Union University, he taught school in Tampa, Florida, (1992-1993). Scott then went into full-time ministry and served at his first church in Fort Myers, Florida, from 1993-1995. On October 22, 1995, he moved to Orlando and accepted the full-time position of Senior Pastor at New Life. He is currently serving the church in this capacity. He also has been a National Speaker for the Fellowship of Christian Athletes for more than 19 years.

Scott spends much of the summer months speaking at various athletic camps across America preaching to thousands of teenagers, young people, and adults. He also speaks at various functions throughout the year. He also serves on his denomination's Mission Board in the State of Florida.
