Power Camp will be here in no time and we are beginning the application process for Huddle Leaders and Junior Huddle Leaders.

This year's Power Camp will be June 18-22, 2012 at Fredericksburg Christian High School. We are looking for junior high, high school, and college students (ages 13+) to serve as leaders for the 8-12 year old campers.

**Please prayerfully consider serving at Power Camp 2012. We are looking for students who demonstrate that they want to be leaders by:**

- 1) Filling out your own application. Applications that are filled out by parents will not be considered.
- 2) Corresponding directly with the FCA office. If you are filling out an application and have a question, we want to hear from you. Contact from parents of campers is appropriate, but for leaders, we want you to show initiative and leadership and contact us directly. **Almost every year we have more applicants than positions available, special consideration will be given to applicants who are:**

- 1) Involved with the FCA ministry throughout the school year, including your campus huddle (if one is available) and attending the area-wide events during the school year.
- 2) Members of sports teams.
- 3) Available to attend the training scheduled for Saturday, June 16 (plan on the whole day, the exact times to be announced). All huddle leaders and junior huddle leaders are required to attend this training/teambuilding session. More details will be given upon selection.
- 4) Servants: Being a huddle leader will likely involve having a lot of fun, but the primary reason to apply and the #1 attribute that the FCA staff is looking for is serving. Campers get to focus on having fun, leaders must focus on serving.

**Serving at Power Camp is a volunteer position, but there are many benefits to you being there for the week:**

- Your week of serving, growing, stretching, and fun counts toward your community service hours for school (about 55 hours).
- Every leader receives a \$50 scholarship to go to FCA Leadership Mini-Camp (June 8-10).
- Great time of fellowship and building lasting Christian friendships with other leaders your age!
- The opportunity to pour into young athletes (they say their favorite part about camp was their huddle leader!)

After praying about this, mail your application to the FCA office by Friday, April 6. Positions are limited. Your application will be reviewed and we will prayerfully make placements after reviewing all applications. You will be notified by email on May 7, 2012.

  - Monitor your Huddle's needs at all times.
  - Be responsible for Huddle members at all times!!!
  - Keep Huddle on schedule.
  - Keep Huddle attendance/records (training provided).
  - Lead Huddle Times (training/material provided).
  - Mentor your junior huddle leader.
  - Maintain group and individual discipline.
  - Eat meals/snacks with your Huddle.
  - Keep Huddle Room/Hall/Area neat and orderly.
  - Follow the direction of the head coach during practice times.
  - Participate in Clinics/Recreation/Worship – be a role model.
  - Be a Christ-like example during competitions.
  - Enforce POWER CAMP rules (hand-out provided in training).
  - Be available to counsel Huddle members if necessary and refer individuals with counseling needs to the appropriate staff persons.
  - Attend daily End-of-Day Huddle Leader Meeting.
